



## **Annex I - Selected Bibliography of Foundation Directories**

**Adresar 1997 Nadaci, Obcanskych Sdruzeni a Cirkevnych Organizaci, (3<sup>rd</sup> ed.) Praha, 1997, 339pages**

Contains details of over 1,000 non-profit organizations in the Czech Republic. The introduction and indexes are in English, French and German.

**The Australian Directory of Philanthropy, Melbourne, 1998/9 146 pages**

Contains details of over 300 trusts and foundations listed in alphabetical order that provide grants and funding in Australia and overseas.

**Canadian Directory of Foundations and Grants, Toronto, 1996/7**

Contains details of 1.200 of Canada's largest foundations including a grants listing for each foundation of grants over CDN\$ 5.000. Fully indexed by foundation, subject and geography.

**Complete Guide to Top US International Foundation Grantmakers, United Kingdom, 1998 111 pages**

This guide is designed to enable organizations outside the USA to find US foundations to support them. It contains details of 95 US foundations and has grantmaking budgets over US\$ 500.000. Contains an index, guidelines for approaching US foundations and information on finances, application deadlines and how to approach them.

**Directorio de las Fundaciones Espanolas, Madrid, 1986 247 pages**

Contains information on 1.311 Spanish foundations classified by region and alphabetically. Also contains a subject index and regional index.

**Directory of Foundations in Estonia, Tallinn, 1996, 50 pages**

Contains contact details of over details of over 100 organizations, including all the members of the Network of Non-Profit Associations and Foundations in Estonia.

**The Directory of Grantmaking Trusts (16<sup>th</sup> ed.), (CAF), 1999/2000 3 volumes**

Aims to keep fundraising organizations in touch with the ongoing changes in the funding priorities of trusts in the UK. Volume 1 is in the form of indexes, listing trusts by geographical area, funding priority and beneficiary type plus a list of trusts by grant type and an index of useful supplies and services. Volume 2 is a register of trusts in alphabetical order, with core data. Volume 3 highlights major trusts, providing more details profiles of the nature and activities of the top 300 trusts.

**The Directory of Grantmaking Trusts (Focus Series): Grants Index, (CAF), 1997 105 pages**

Contains details of the actual grants made by many of the UK's leading grantmaking trusts arranged in alphabetical order. Details on the trusts' stated objectives and funding priorities are also included.



**The Directory of Grantmaking Trusts (Focus Series): Children and Youth, (CAF), 1996, 227 pages**

Looks at trusts that support children and youth in the UK and Northern Ireland. Contains indexes of 15 different fields of interest, and beneficial area. Individual entries on each trust are listed in this directory.

**Education Funding in Europe Volume 1, (EFC), 1995 380 pages**

Directory of 205 foundation and corporate funders that actively support education across Europe. Contains detailed indexes and full funder details.

**Environmental Funding in Europe, (EFC) 1998 196 pages**

Directory of 190 foundations and corporate funders which are active in the environment field within Europe. Contains six detailed indexes and full funder details.

**European Grants Index, (EFC), 1998, 224 pages**

Lists over 1.750 grants and programmes supported by 78 foundations and corporate funders active in Europe. Contains detailed indexes and a statistical analysis of this data.

**Fondswijzer 1997, Amsterdam, 1997, 157 pages**

Contains profiles of 158 grantmaking organizations in the Netherlands. Includes an alphabetical and subject index as well as profiles and contact details of each funder.

**The Foundation Grants Index, New York, 1996, 2.130 pages**

Covers the grantmaking programmes of more than 1.000 of the largest, independent, corporate and community foundations in the USA. Contains over 73.000 grant descriptions and contains indexes on 28 broad subject areas, arranged geographically by state and alphabetically by name.

**Foreign Funds and Aid Programmes Available to Non-Profit Organizations in Latvia, Riga, 1997, 103 pages**

A directory listing funds and programmes available to organizations in Latvia. Contains information on target group, fields of interest, purpose and activities.

**Fondsenboek, 1999/2000, The Hague, 1997, 313 pages**

Contains information of 538 foundations in the Netherlands with contact details. Includes alphabetical and subject indexes.

**GAFA: Guide Annuaire des Fondations et des Associations, France, 1995**

Contains information on 600 French non-profit organizations, including foundations. Includes indexes by name and field of activity.

**Guia das Fundações Portuguesas/ Portuguese Foundation Guide, Lisbon, 1996, 375 pages**

Contains details of over 200 Portuguese foundations in Portuguese and English. Includes profiles of the foundations including their chronological development, distribution of grants and their status.



**The Guide Book to Funding Resources for Romania, Bucharest, 1996/97, 53 pages**

An outline of trusts funding disadvantages groups in Romania. Contact details and some of the areas of interest of the trusts.

**Guide to Funding for International and Foreign Programs, New York, 1998, 430 pages**

This volume is intended as a starting point for grantseekers looking for support for international and foreign programs. Contains detailed profiles of foundations and corporate funders resident in the USA. Fully indexed.

**International Foundation Directory, (8<sup>th</sup> ed.) London, 1998, 875 pages**

Directory of international foundations, trusts and other similar non-profit institutions on a world scale. Contains information on over 1.500 new and established foundations arranged alphabetically by country. Over 100 countries are represented in this edition.

**The Irish Funding Book, Dublin, 1994, 178 pages**

Provides information on sources of funding for voluntary and community initiatives in Ireland, North and south. Lists sources from trusts, statutory sector, corporate sector and the European Union.

**Kompendium Finančních Zdrojů Pro Nevladní Neziskové Organizace, Prague, 1996**

Contains detailed information on more than 100 foundations in the Czech republic. Includes alphabetical and subject indexes.

**Maecenata Stiftungsführer, München, 1998, 339 pages**

Directory of German foundations with profiles of their aims, types of grants, application procedures and limitations.

**Maecenata Unternehmenführer, München, 1997, 223 pages**

Directory of German corporations with contact details and types of activities and events supported.

**Mediterranean Funding, EFC, 1998, 175 pages**

Contains detailed profiles of 126 organizations from 24 countries involved with funding in the Mediterranean region.

Provides advice on grant applications and identifying potential partners for cooperative projects.

**Non-Governmental Organizations in Bulgaria, Sofia, 1997, 358 pages**

Supported by the Civil Society Development Foundation and the Sofia Foundation, this directory contains detailed information on over 400 non-profit organizations, including foundations. Alphabetical and subject indexes included.

**Non-profit Onarckép '96-Non-Profit Self-portrait '96, Budapest, 1997, 360 pages**

Contains detailed profiles of over 600 non-profit organizations in Hungary in Hungarian and English. Also available on the Internet at [www.niok.hu](http://www.niok.hu)

Contains profiles of 140 Hungarian grantmaking organizations.

Provides information on French corporate citizenship programmes in the fields of culture and social solidarity. Includes a detailed subject index.

Contains profiles of over 1.300 foundations based in Switzerland. Includes a subject index.

Contains detailed profiles on over 6.500 German foundations including contact details and programme objectives. Includes a subject index and a geographical index by city of location.
